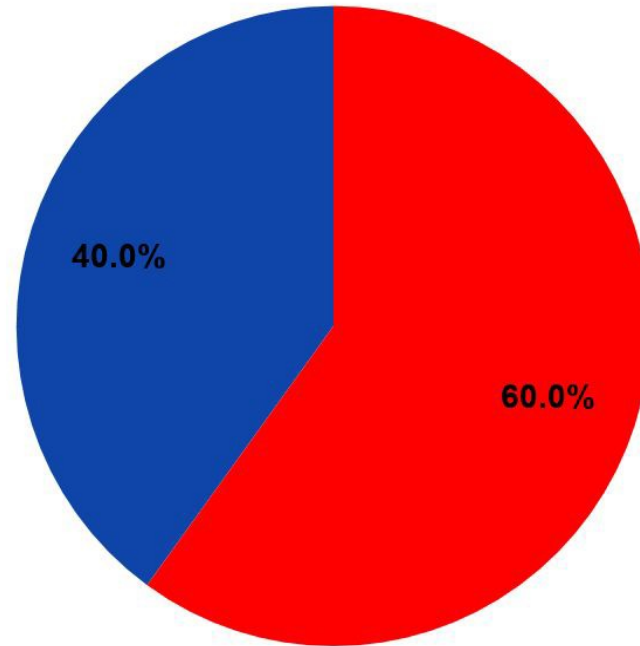

● Greater than 5 years ● Less than 5 years





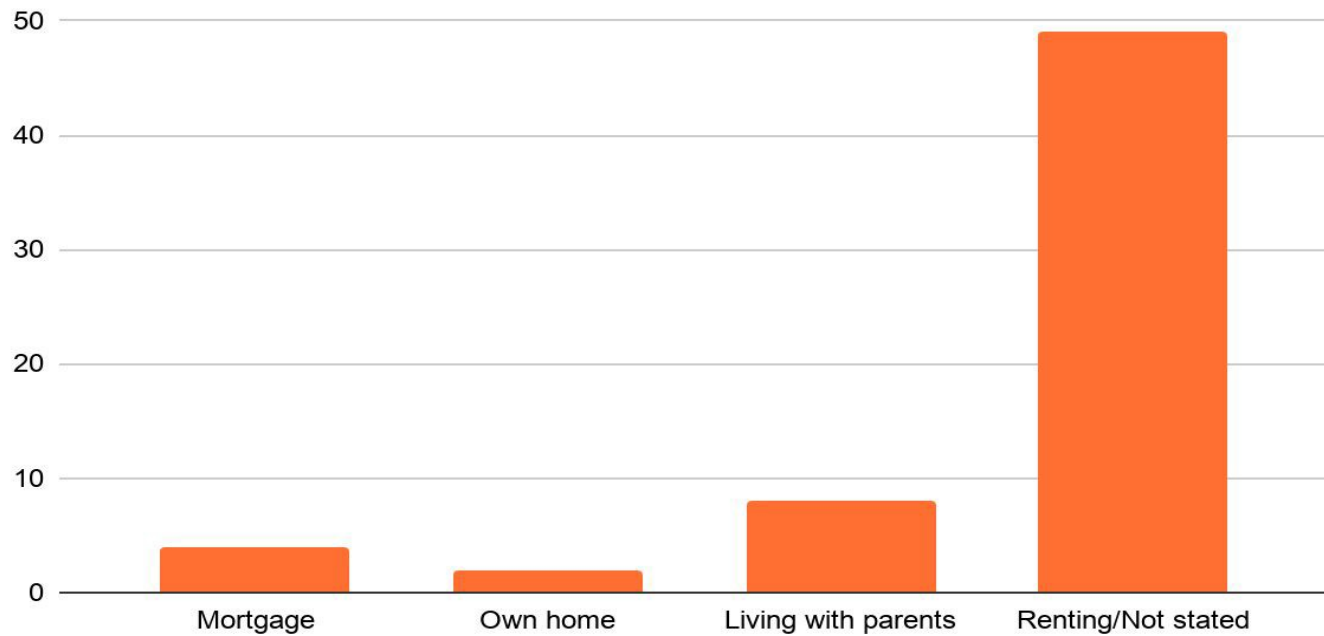
Almost 20 years experience. Last 7 years in the same school

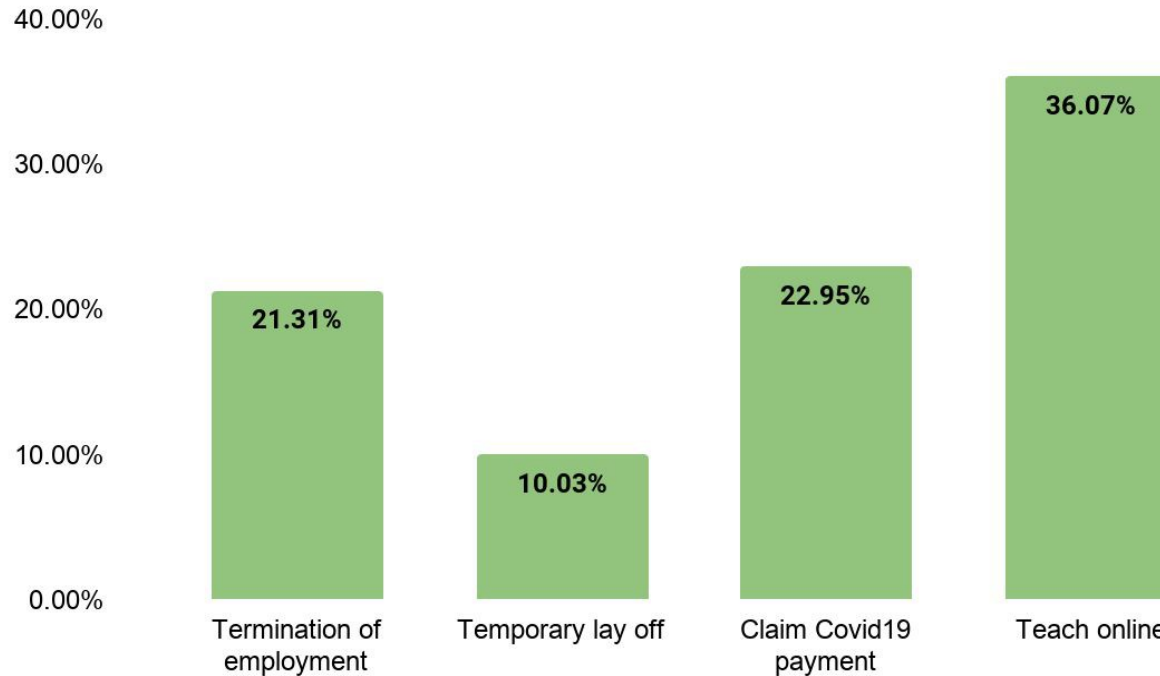


Household Tenure: Status



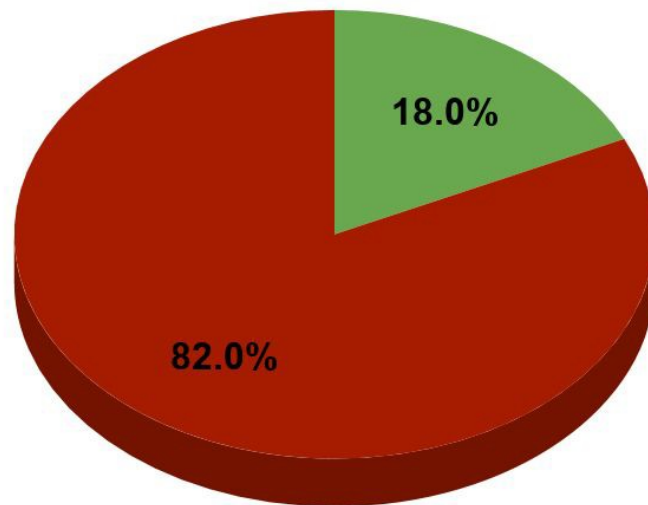
What arrangements were proposed for teaching staff?

Arrangements proposed for teachers





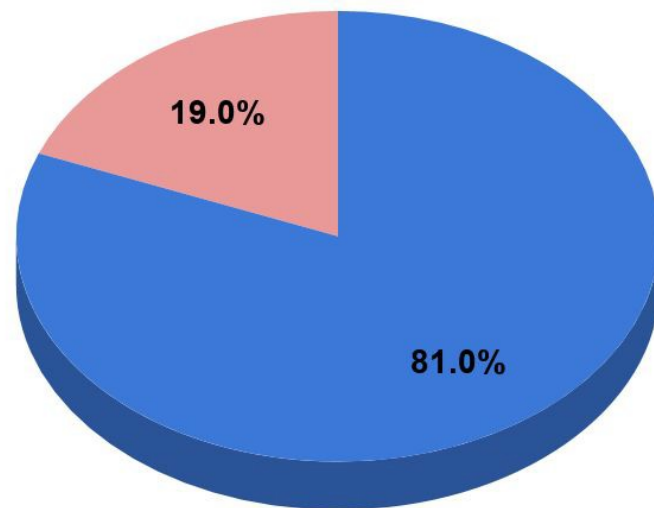
Retained on Wage Subsidy Scheme?

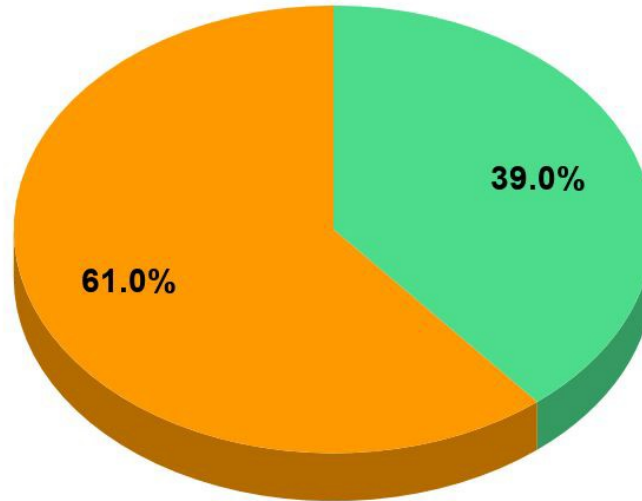
Teaching online offered by school?

Teachers given training to teach online?

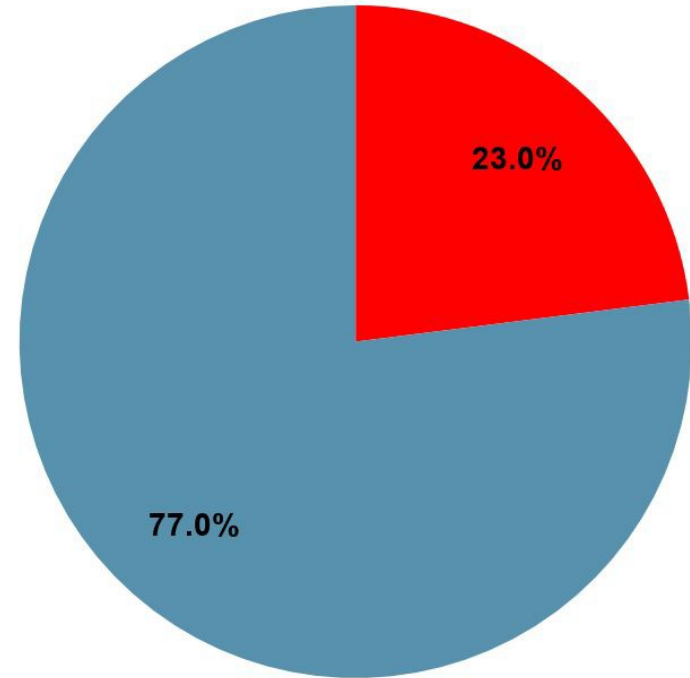

- Employment terminated



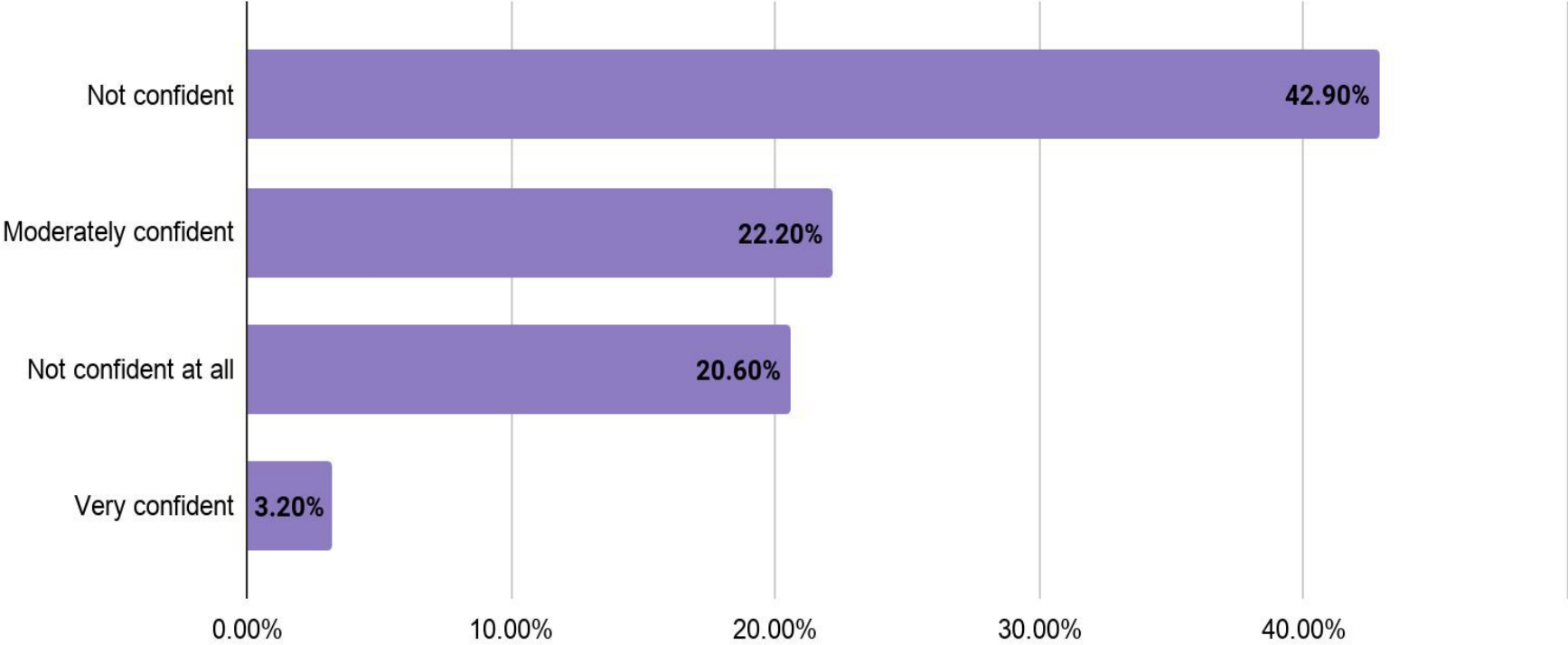


Return to work survey results October 2020

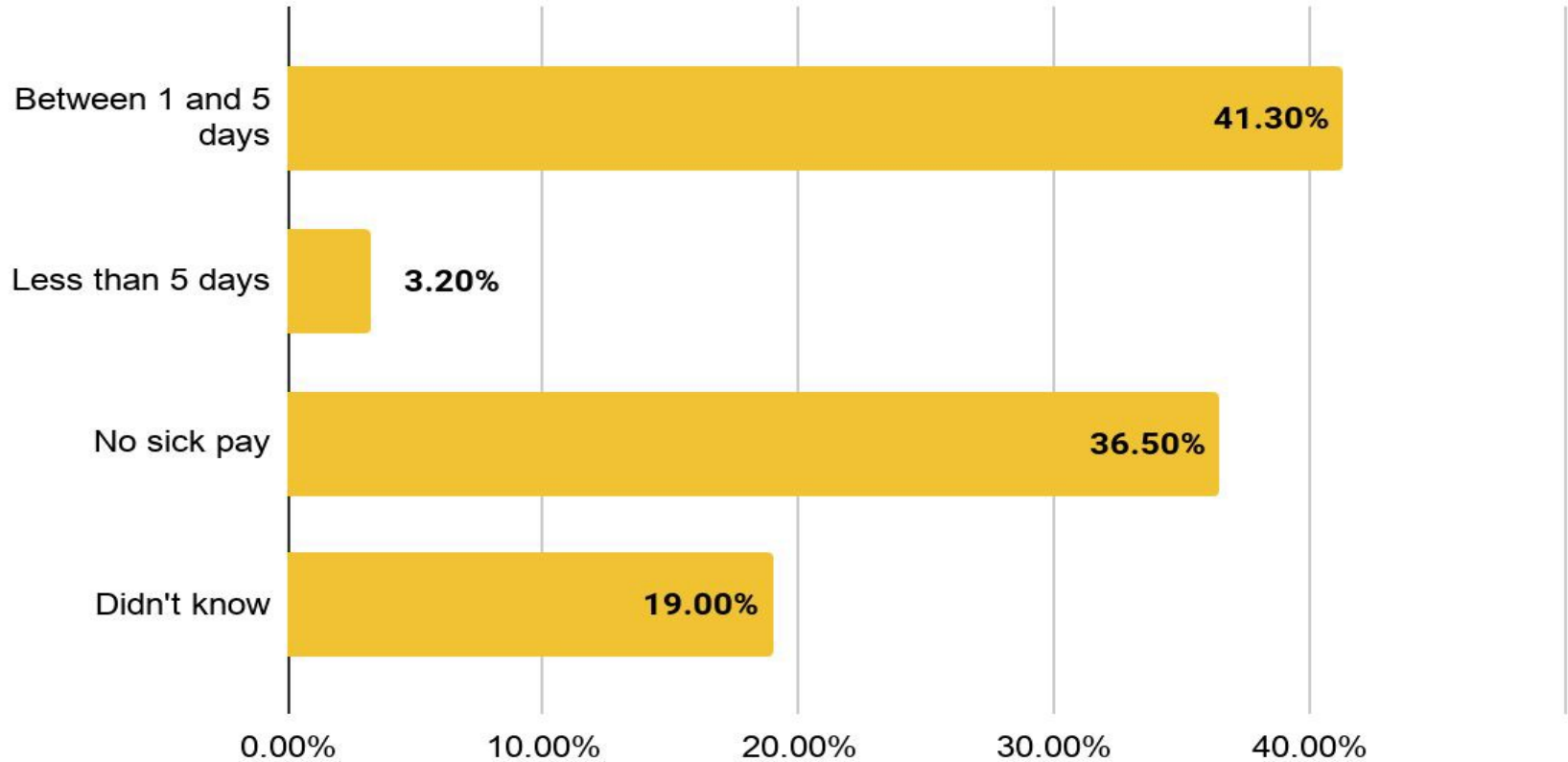
Question 1 How people felt about face to face classes in their school at that moment?

- 15.9% saying they felt safe with the current face to face classes

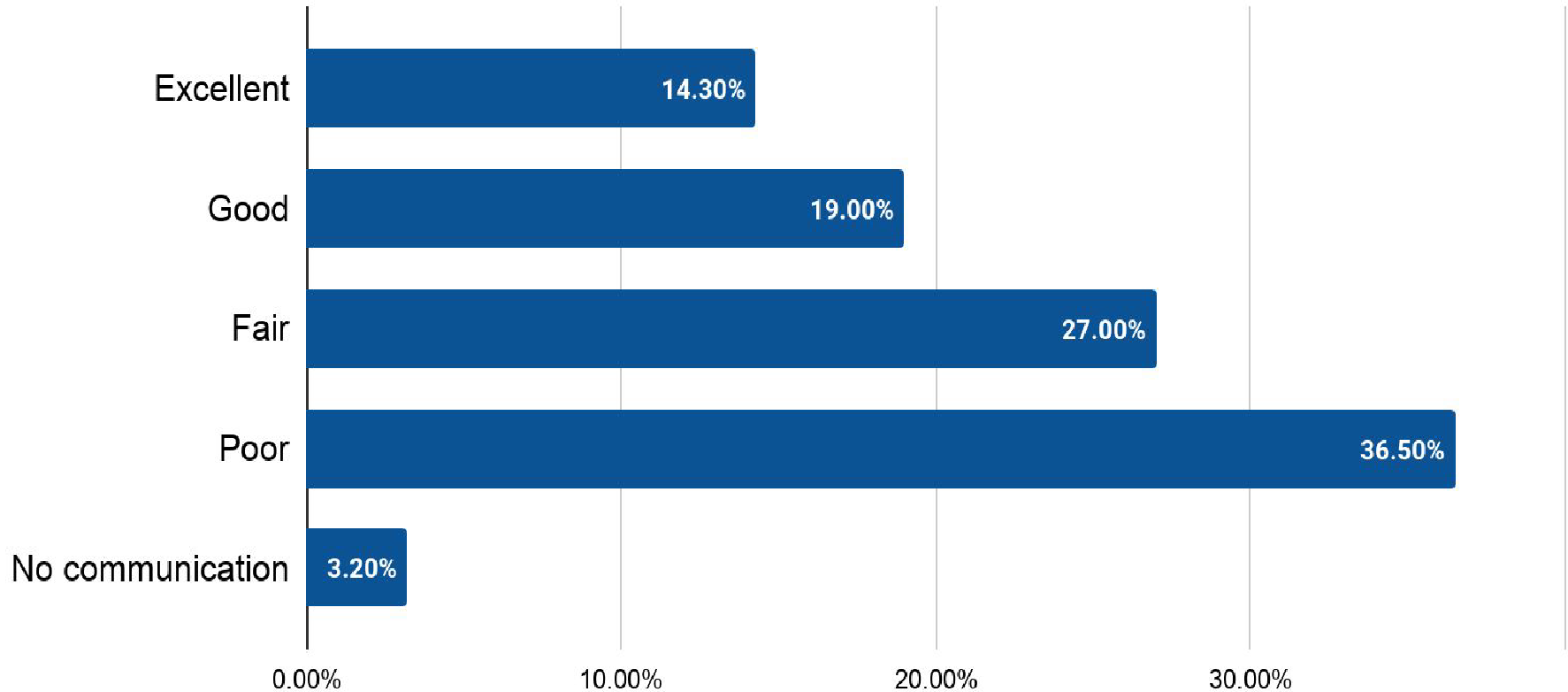
How confident are you that schools will implement all government protocols regarding safety?
